

Oracle Requisition Form Descriptive Flex Field for Capital Assets

The descriptive flex field (DFF) on the Oracle Requisition Form is accessed by clicking the [button] and is used by the requisitioner to provide general capital asset and non-capital purchase attributes for each requisition line. Requisitioners should populate fields named with all capital letters. The Property Accounting department populates additional information in the DFF for the field names that are in sentence case. The information entered in the requisition DFF should be in all capital letters and is necessary to create a capital asset record within the Oracle Fixed Assets (OFA) module.
