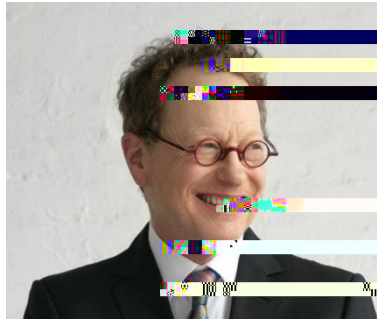




Dr. Edward (Ed) H. Frank
