The description should give the participant an overviewhere researchincluding what the participant will be asked to do, how long it will take, where it will take place.

3. Risks and benefitshould be mentioned and to the extent to which any are expected.

If no risks are expected that can be plainly stated as well as any possible benefits. Note that payments are not consided a benefit to participation. Payments are compensation for time and effort.

4. Indicate what compensation f any, will be provided.

The payment can take the form of cash, gift cards, course credit, candy bar, etc.

5. Explain how confidentiality of all information provided will be protected.

If data is collected anonymously that should be stated, if not, a general statement
